### **Leisure Pool Rules**

- \_ALL patrons must shower before entering the pool.
- \_Patrons known or suspected of having communicable or skin disease, open wounds, inflamed eyes, nasal or ear discharge, are not allowed in the pool.
- \_Appropriate swim attire is required. Thongs, athletic shorts or street clothing is not permitted.
- \_Non-toilet trained children must wear tight fitting plastic pants or swim diapers.
- \_Children under the age of 6 and all children less than 48 inches tall who are not proficient swimmers must be accompanied by a supervising adult in swim attire within arm's reach in the pool.
- \_Non swimmers should stay in beach entry area.
- \_Diving, pushing, back dives, flips and spins from the side of pool are prohibited.
- \_Noodles, floats, inflatable devices, or kickboards are not allowed in the pool unless they are being used with a program.
- \_Only U.S. Coast Guard Personal Flotation Devices (PFD's) are permitted with adult supervision.
- \_Pool items brought from home may be removed at the discretion of the aquatic staff if deemed unsafe, unserviceable, or if it otherwise interferes with the safety and comfort of other patrons.
- \_Contact a Lifeguard if you need assistance.
- \_Please report any injuries, incidents or equipment problems immediately to staff.
- \_The Lifeguard staff may prohibit any behavior deemed unsafe or disruptive.

### **Water Slide Rules**

- \_Patrons under 48 inches tall must pass a swim test before being allowed access to the water slide.
- \_Only one patron is permitted on the slide at a time.
- \_Patrons using slides must ride feet first, lying down on their backs.
- \_After sliding, patrons must exit the landing area immediately. Catching patrons at the bottom of the slide is prohibited.
- \_Each patron must wait for instructions before entering the slide.
- \_Stopping or stalling on the water slide and other conduct that may endanger another patron is prohibited.
- \_Patrons may not take, or ride on any rafts, flotation devices, goggles or other object while on the slide.
- \_Swimsuits with rivets or other metal fasteners are prohibited.
